

Journey Sewing 2 Class Supply List

To begin the class, you will need:

- A working sewing machine
- pins and pin cushion
- fabric scissors and paper scissors
- measuring tape
- seam gauge
- seam ripper
- marking pencils
- needles (for your machine) and thread

We will be completing 4 main projects throughout the course. We will be discussing pattern and fabric options during class; that way if they have questions, I can help them problem solve before they go out and buy items. I will supply the fabric for the first project. You will need to provide the fabric for the other 3 projects:

1. **Pocket aprons:** I will provide the pattern. You will need ½ yard of two different (coordinating) cotton fabrics (woven, not knit). Pre-wash before class!
2. **Tote Bags:** I will provide a pattern. You will need ½ yard of outer base fabric, and 1 yard for the straps, top of bag, and lining. I recommend a sturdy cotton fabric or even home décor/duckcloth fabric. If you use duckcloth, you will only need 2/3 yard for the second fabric and ½ yard of cotton fabric for the lining. You will also need 1 yard of heavy, fusible interfacing (not necessary for home décor/duckcloth fabric).
3. **Skirts:** 1 yard of main fabric (cotton), ½ yard contrasting fabric (cotton), 1 package of 1” wide elastic. Prewash fabric.

You can find all of these sewing supplies at Joann fabrics or on Amazon. Also, Joann has an app and a mailer for coupons that you can sign up for. I highly recommend this!!
